At the regularly scheduled meeting of the Chattanooga Fire and Police Pension Fund Board of Trustees held on the 15th day of July 2021, President Joe Shaw presided. The meeting was held at the Pension Office, 6009 John Douglass Drive, Chattanooga, TN 37421.

The meeting convened at 0905 hours with board members Joe Shaw, Britt Bradshaw, Nathan Vaughn, Scott Sparks, Brent Goldberg and Chris Hopkins. Attorneys Bill Robinson and Ashley Gibson were also present. Cal Long and Phillip McClain were excused absences.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

LEGAL UPDATE

Attorney Bill Robinson informed the Board of new legislation effective July 1, 2021 that allows any member of the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System (TCRS) to purchase their actual prior service with a previous political subdivision retirement system upon request; with the previous retirement system being required to transfer all employee and employer contributions made by or on behalf of the member and reasonable interest to TCRS. The Board discussed its potential impact and noted that neither the Fund nor its attorney was made aware of any such legislation prior to passage.
