## INVESTMENT REPORT

Barry Bryant of Dahab Associates presented the 3Q-2022 performance summary. As of September 30, 2022, the Fund has returned -4.6% for the quarter and ranked in the 60<sup>th</sup> percentile of the Public Fund Universe. Over the trailing twelve-month period, the Fund returned –14.8% and ranked in the 60<sup>th</sup> percentile of the Public Fund Universe. The performance summary does not include updated results from all managers. The Board also discussed managers that were not beating the benchmark and will review their performance at the next quarterly review.
