We would like to thank Fire Engineer Cal Long for his dedicated service to the Board. Board elections for Fire will be held at the Pension Fund Office and the Training Center. Board elections for Police will be held at the Pension Fund Office only. A government issued photo I.D. is required to vote.

I want to encourage you to vote for a candidate to represent your voice on the Fire and Police Pension Fund Board of Trustees. This is one of the many ways you can participate and influence the direction of your pension. Active, retired and vested members of the Chattanooga Fire and Police Departments are eligible to vote for the candidate of their respective department.

The Fund is pleased to report that it has returned 5.6% for the second quarter of 2021, outperforming 70% of other public pension funds. Over the trailing twelve-month period, the Fund returned 29.8%, outperforming 83% of other public pension funds. The Board has and continues to work diligently to meet the needs of our participants.
